- 2. 300 homes must have 250 votes to accept but doesn't carry over
- 3. Proceed as have been having architectural committee and go to court when necessary as violations occur.

Voted to update bylaws at November annual meeting the second Tuesday in November 10, 2015

Article 6 replace Independence Day and add Architectural Committee that is so referenced in the restrictive covenance which is published on the website.

3 voted yes and 1 opposition vote.

Next a vote was cast to reject term limit in bylaws due to difficulty in obtaining volunteers. 3 board members voted for and 1 opposed.

The Chairman of the committee reported that he told our neighbor that no one on the Architectural Committee had contacted the City of Raleigh and asked if any members of the BOD had contacted the City regarding an unpermitted retaining wall.
